ART IS SMART!

This month features our Spring Art Show. Why is art such an important part of our curriculum?

Art allows the following:

- Expression of feelings and emotions in a safe and healthy way
- * Practice and strengthening of fine muscle control and eye-hand coordination
- * Development of perceptual abilities; awareness of colors, shapes, forms, lines and textures
- Opportunity to make choices and solve problems (What color should I use? How do I form a dinosaur out of playdough?)
- * Experience of success! Because art leaves the end open to the creator, all children experience a measure of success
- * Awareness of mathematical concepts such as different sizes, shapes and lines
- Awareness of physical science concepts such as paint texture, paint changes when mixed together, paint resists when applied over crayon
- * Emergence of language and the vocabulary or art
- Development of social skills by sharing supplies, creating a group mural or project, cleaning up together

Take a closer look at the art projects that come home or are displayed. Art IS smart!
