Lent begins next week: The Callings That Find Us

Last year, our Lenten time of renewal included a series of Wednesday night sessions called "On the Journey With Jesus: Stories of the Callings That Find Us." Call assumes that God is not merely an idea or just "out there" somewhere running the universe. God is active, alive, and present in and through personal and historical life. "Calling" means God pulls us toward faith, hope, and love in human lives. All of us have that tug toward something the Lord offers us. Part of our understanding of call, though, is that God does not run our lives like a puppeteer, but invites us in freedom to respond.

The practical truth about this is that we bear some responsibility. Music has a phrase for this called "call and response," when one person sings and another person answers. A call always assumes a little space for the other to answer the call. Last year, songwriter Kate Campbell, neurologist Dr. Daniel Potts, contemporary Christian singer Dan Hazeltine, and professor and activist Dr. Jenny Dyer all told us stories of lives that turned into new places. Each speaker shared their Christian faith from a variety of backgrounds and stories and the unexpected turns that took them to new places in their discipleship.

Lent is a time of invitation to deepen, to grow, but also, to listen for God's tug at your heart and life into something better. By listening to others' stories, we can learn to pay better attention to our own. This year our series continues with four different stories. And again, they have not moved in straight lines but, like the people of scripture, in many ways as they found their way to God's extraordinary presence in their lives. I hope you will plan to come and invite others.


Sacred Encounters Adult Seminar Room


