SINCE SUMMER BEGAN, I HAVE ENJOYED EXPERIENCING THE WONDERFUL SUMMER MINISTRIES OF VESTAVIA HILLS BAPTIST FOR THE FIRST TIME.

It was one of the most beautiful expressions of intergenerational children's ministry I've ever witnessed.

Throughout the summer – from the Chicago mission trip to VBS to Passport – the energy, fellowship, service, kindness, deepness, and love of our teenagers, leaders, and ministers has shined brightly. 




