

IMPORTANT WORD

I've always been interested in etymologies, word origins. Did you know the word "muscle" is derived from the Latin word for "little mouse" because muscle movement like in the bicep was thought to resemble a tiny rodent? "Denim" comes from "de Nîmes," which the town in France where the fabric originated. The name of P.T. Barnum's six-ton circus elephant gives us the word "jumbo."

An important word we consider in this season of our Anew emphasis is "worship." This word comes from Old English "worth" + "ship" meaning "condition of being worthy." The holiday season is nearly upon us and we'll have tremendous opportunities to decide what is worthy of our time, attention, and financial resources. Our participation in Thanksgiving gatherings, Christmas parties, and gift exchanges all reflect some of the implicit value, or worth-ship, we place on them.

Opportunities for corporate worship at Vestavia Hills Baptist Church abound during this season, too. On the last Sunday of the liturgical year, Reign of Christ, which also happens to be the Sunday before Thanksgiving, we'll gather around the Lord's table for communion or eucharist (from the Greek for "thanksgiving"). Then we move into the Advent season - four weeks of preparation and anticipation. Hanging of the Green, the Sanctuary Choir's "New Life, New Hope, New Joy" presentation, Children's Choir, and the Handbell Choir make the season so special.

We'll also gather for a Service on Consolation - an opportunity to grieve and be offered hope, not only around death, but also job loss, illness, divorce, loneliness, strained relationships, etc. Christmastide brings worship gatherings on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day as well as the celebration of Epiphany.

This year, we'll also be offering a special personal Advent worship guide: Journey to Bethlehem. Each week will feature written reflections from church members on the Advent themes of hope, peace, joy, and love as well as for Christmas Eve/Day. There are also worship prompts for each day that offer accessible opportunities for prayer, meditation, listening to Christmas carols, and putting Advent themes into action. Accompanying the written material will be a weekly audio podcast with the authors reading their own reflections.

Consider anew this season what is worthy of your time, attention, and financial resources. Participate in corporate and personal worth-ship with Vestavia Hills Baptist Church. Open yourself to new opportunities to be made more like Christ each day.

Thank you so much for your thoughts and prayers for the Andersons over the past week and a half.

After five nights in ICU and two nights in the step-down unit, Karen is home. These first days home have been full of getting ourselves organized for a lengthy recovery and with rediscovering the simple joys and comfort of the familiarity and routine of home.

Karen's recovery process will be slow and will give us many opportunities to learn patience. The blood clots that went from her leg, through her heart, and into both lungs are being addressed with medication over the next several months. The blood thinners she was given the first few days to dissolve the clots did damage to the knee that had surgery 2 1/2 weeks ago. The healing and recovery of the knee will take weeks or months, not days.

But, we are blessed. We have been humbled and overwhelmed by the out-pouring of love from our church family and friends - prayers, food, cards, texts, phone calls. It will be a while before Karen will be back at church. But, we look forward to being together again with our family at VHBC and our friends in the community. We feel loved and we love you all.

TV show is Seinfeld and her favorite movie is Sixteen Candles.






