SHARING OF A LIFE

At our recent SAM (Senior Adult Ministry) sponsored Speakers Luncheon last Friday, Rev. Chuck Poole described his book The Path to Depth like this, "The book tells my story of swimming deeper towards Jesus and then floating outward to the world." That sentence reminded me of the 1968 book by Elizabeth O'Connor, Journey Inward, Journey Outward in which she described the innovative congregation The Church of the Savior in Washington, DC. In my 2010 D.Min thesis, I described this same idea with the less poetic words, Missional Formation.

Each of these phrases describes the transformative work of God's Spirit growing in our lives. The more we move towards Jesus, the more Jesus sends us out into the world. Spiritual growth is the daily process of moving inward towards Jesus so Jesus can send us outwards towards others. Daily...Hourly...Growth. Chuck Poole says in his acknowledgements in his book, "new light on old truth com[es] to us slowly, eventually, while walking in the Spirit of God with the people of God."




This is another aspect of *Growing Together*. Each of us walks an individual path as we follow Jesus. Yet, while the path is ours, we are not alone. The Spirit of God accompanies us as the people of God surround us.

Thomas Kelly, a mid-20th century Quaker writer on spirituality, has shaped me in my swims towards the depths of Jesus. His most famous book is *A Testament of Devotion*. In describing the early church's sharing of physical goods, Kelly writes, "[this] is only an outcropping of the profoundly deeper sharing of a Life, the base and center of which is obscured, to those who are still oriented about self, rather than about God." He continues, "every period of profound rediscovery of God's joyous immediacy is a period of emergence of this amazing group interknittedness of God-enthralled men and women who know one another *in Him*."

Growing as individual Christians in our Christlikeness comes through the connection of other God-enthralled men and women. We need one another as we grow as Christians, spouses, parents, friends, co-workers, and servants. We walk this path together.

I am grateful to walk beside each of you as we all walk the path to depth – inward towards Jesus and outwards toward the world.
