
By now many of us know the origin story of our Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF). Born out of a theological narrowing of the Southern Baptist Convention in 1991, CBF established itself as a fellowship, a big tent, of individuals and churches who desired to work together for kingdom ministry. CBF sends out field personnel around the world; commissions chaplains in hospitals, businesses, and the US military; plants churches; and nurtures the faith of many individuals and congregations.

TODAY, CBF DEFINES ITSELF THIS WAY,

The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship is a Christian network comprised of individuals and churches that work together to spread the hope of Christ. For 30 years, CBF has been driven by its mission to serve Christians and churches as they discover and fulfill their God-given mission and to live into our vision to be a national and global community bearing witness to the Gospel in partnership with Christians across the nation and around the world.

Two years later, Alabama CBF began a fellowship of churches in Alabama. While the global and state organizations are unique, they work together in ministry.

I attended my first Global CBF Assembly in Fort Worth, Texas in 1995. I was in seminary at the time. While I was not associated with CBF at the time, I discovered a kinship among the Baptists I met. I realized quickly; these are my people.

Search committee message

The Student Minister Search Committee is making progress! We have been meeting since August on a regular basis, collecting congregational feedback from different groups and planning for the upcoming interview process. To provide access to greater resources and networks, the committee engaged Dr. Bill Owen, former VHBC interim pastor, with the Center for Healthy Churches to assist our efforts.

The committee is composed of Grace Baker, Jennifer Carter, Jason Cooper, Brandon Hughey, Caroline Nordlund, Howard Finch (Chair), and Mike McBrayer (Staff). To date, interviews have been conducted to seek feedback with the active participants in our student ministries, their parents, the Youth Ministry team, and each individual member of the church's pastoral staff. Working alongside the personnel committee, a formal job description with required qualifications was developed, and the position has been posted with the national Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, the Alabama Cooperative Baptist and other state CBFs, several seminaries, the Baptist Women in Ministry national network and other informal networks.

We are currently developing an updated Congregational Profile, a series of interview questions, and an internal evaluation scorecard to help evaluate candidates. We hope to begin the formal interview process soon. Please pray for the Holy Spirit to lead the committee to the next Student Minister who will come alongside our pastoral staff and deepen the faith of our students!


