

Pastor Search Committee Update


You will recall from the Church Profile presentation by the Transition Team, our committee was tasked with developing the Cover Letter (invitation to candidates) and a brief description of the profile of the characteristics you would like to see in our next Pastor. Over the last several weeks you helped us tremendously by participating in the Pastor Profile survey and the accompanying collaboration sessions. Our committee members have also conducted one-on-one meetings with our ministerial staff to gain insight and to allow them to share their thoughts on the qualities of a pastor that would fit well with this excellent group we have assembled here.

We have now completed the Cover Letter and the Pastor Profile, and we are ready to begin receiving resumes from candidates. The Church Profile, which includes the Cover Letter from our committee and a brief pastor profile statement, has been completed and it will soon be released through the Center for Healthy Churches, and the active search process will commence. Some of our aspirations for our next Senior Pastor include someone who...

- Responds to the Holy Spirit and feels God's call to lead our church
- Displays rigorous preaching, teaching, and scholarship based on Scripture


