# Shepherd's Encourager

What a time this has been. We have gone from a gathered church to a virtual congregation, at least for now. So much has changed. And yet amid the upheaval, so much stays together. And so many new good things have happened. I shared with our deacons in our online meeting on Sunday evening that in the services we've done online since mid-March (not counting our Wednesday evenings), our Sunday services and Holy Week services have passed six thousand viewings. The Good Friday service, which involved fifteen of our members (counting John Pleasant's amazing artistic presentation), was viewed eight hundred times. We are reaching out with the gifts of our congregation.

And there is terrible disruption everywhere we turn. And uncertainty. A good time for a resurrection people.

The filter through which the early church understood the story of Jesus was the resurrection. The early Christians were convinced that Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified by the Romans, had been raised to life by God. The entire story of Jesus, then, is understandable only in reverse. By viewing it through the conviction born on Easter, we understand the whole meaning of his life, his teachings, and even his death.

After Easter, we have not only the reflections of the church about Jesus before the resurrection—we have accounts of the teachings and sayings that the disciples claimed to have heard from the Risen Lord. Now, from this new vantage point, the disciples were able to understand the past.


