## SHEPHERD'S ENCOURAGER

DR. GARY FURR



In the coming weeks, I will continue my sermons on "The Ministry of Reconciliation." On Wednesday evenings, I will be doing a Bible study before each of those sermons that connect what we're talking about to our ministry to our culture at this moment.

It is important because it rises above the vista of political divisions, ethnic and racial pain, family problems, and economic strife. There is a profoundly spiritual truth at this moment—a summons to be reconciled to God and one another.

At the core of so many struggles at the moment is the hunger for community and communion we all need. At the very time that we need one another, we find ourselves raw with uncertainty and anxiety. Contradictory information and conflicting prescriptions leave so many of us unsure where to turn.

I want to talk about the four dimensions of God's reconciling work in Jesus Christ—in our spiritual lives, in our relationships with one another, in the divisions of our world, and the Kingdom vision of God for the whole of creation. I will reflect on this in biblical stories from the Old Testament and the New—Ruth, Jonah, the Samaritan Woman, Cornelius, and the Ethiopian Eunuch. I hope you'll tune in!


