I am so grateful for the privilege of knowing Rosemary. She died on Saturday afternoon and I was with David and the family there. One of the beautiful gifts of the prior week was a surprise phone call from Rosemary. She had been in the hospital for a while, and even David was not able to get in to see her. She had made a list of things and I was one of the items.

She called to tell me the news that she didn't have long to live, although it happened faster than expected. She wanted to tell me about it and we had a good conversation. She was aware and we had a very meaningful prayer time together by phone. I did not know when we hung up that it would be our last conversation.

Rosemary and David Bamberg have been active and deeply committed to our congregation for all of their years here. They both went on mission trips, Rosemary was faithful in the choir, and she also enjoyed volunteering, gardening, and sharing time with friends. She was very proud to have been a nurse for forty years at Princeton Baptist Hospital, some of that time as a staff nurse for Cardiac ICU.

It was a life well lived. We held a small family memorial service on the prayer point behind the sanctuary. Even with the restrictions of this time, it is important to ritually mark the transitions of life, including death. We need moments to remember, to celebrate, to grieve, and to hope.

I will miss Rosemary, as will our church. She was a blessing. We are thankful for David, who has a gift of service. He has given so much time to service in missions and helping wherever needed. We will love him as his church and I know you will offer your prayers and fellowship in his journey ahead.
