INTENTIONAL MISSIONS

VHBC YOUTH IME TEAM

Tomorrow afternoon, fifteen youth and five adults will be leaving for our International Mission Experience in Slovakia. Our youth have been hard at work over the past six months to prepare for this trip, and it has been an honor to watch them grow individually and as a group during this process.

Once we arrive in Slovakia, we will be staying in a town called Lučenec in the southern part of the country. We will be partnering with a local Baptist church and long-term ministry partners Shane and Dianne McNary. Shane and Dianne have lived and worked in eastern Europe as CBF field personnel since 2004. They have worked primarily with the Romani people in Slovakia and the Czech Republic, helping to provide resources, opportunities, and community to a group of people who have experienced centuries of discrimination. As Shane and Dianne wrap up their time in Slovakia before heading back to the United States, I am so thankful that our group gets to experience their ministry in person in the coming weeks.

While in Slovakia, our group will split into two teams; one will be working in Lučenec, while the other will be heading to a nearby village called Cinobaňa. These teams will rotate daily, and each student will spend two days in each place. Both teams will spend the mornings speaking and teaching English to students in local schools. In the afternoon, our Cinobaňa team will lead an afternoon kids' bible study program and fun activities they have planned over the past few months.

Meanwhile, those in Lučenec will be spending time with different groups of people each day; we will lead activities and spend time in fellowship with local families, Ukrainian refugees, and Autistic children. There are so many things that make us feel disconnected from people we do not know. We will experience language and age barriers and differences between our culture and theirs that might feel like an obstacle. I look forward to seeing how our youth find ways to seek out similarities and a sense of community with the people we meet.

Of course, we are not going to go to Europe without having some touristy fun. Our team will spend two days in Vienna, Austria navigating a beautiful city together as we conquer jetlag and nerves. We will also spend a day in Budapest, Hungary, during which we have the opportunity to take a boat tour of the city and learn about its history. These days will be a lot of fun and will be a great time of fellowship with our team as we prepare ourselves for an exciting and intense week ahead

Our team will be in Slovakia to give, to receive, and to be the spirit of Christ to each other and to those we meet. I am so proud of all the work they have accomplished in preparation of the days to come, and I have no doubt that they will navigate the challenges with courage and with grace.




